

### **History**

Chartered in 1920 by John Milton Lee, on the eve of February 20th 1920 on the campus of Temple University, better known as the Crown Jewel, Guide Right became the Fraternity's National Service Program.

B. H. Dillard was the 1st chapter Polemarch and a high ranking studend of dentistry at Temple University in the early 1920's.

Today, National Guide Right programs provide programming, role models, mentors, and financial assistance for at risk youth in communities throughout the country.

### Mission

In order to serve young men between the ages of 5 and 25, the mission of the Guide Right Committee is to promote goals, aims, and objectives of the fraternity, in a manner that is consistent to and appropriate for our targeted audiences. To uphold the original charge of Guide Right, and to incorporate the necessary tools which will enable us to adapt to today's changing landscape and





### **ACHIEVEMENT ACADEMY**

The Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity Inc. Lambda Chapter established its Achievement Academy in 1950's. The fraternity's nationally mandated Guide Right program provides for the development and training of young African-American male students. The Achievement Academy seeks to combat the negative influences in the lives of our impressionable youth with positive values, direction and enhanced self-esteem. The college-educated men of Kappa Alpha Psi have accepted the challenge to motivate the students to assume responsibility for their future success.

The curriculum is designed to begin in October of each year and conclude in May. This is to allow for synchronization with the students' academic year. The sessions are the second and fourth Wednesdays of the month and are an hour and a half in duration. We are in the process of approving this years location and will provide that information on October 23rd at the orientation session. Weekend trips are incorporated into the program with the objective of helping the students to associate these topics with real world experiences.

### JOHN MILTON LEE SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The Lambda Chapter of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity seeks to enhance higher educational opportunities for qualified graduates of the Philadelphia public school system through our John Milton Lee Scholarship Award.
